INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL STUDY MODES

Note that not all units can be taken in external mode. The list over-page specifies those units that can be taken externally. All units can be taken in internal mode.

*Coptic Units

Two dialects of Coptic are taught: Sahidic and Bohairic. These are taught in alternative years (in 2010, Coptic I and Coptic II will be Bohairic). It is therefore necessary that Coptic II is taken in the same year as Coptic I, to ensure that it is a continuation of the same dialect.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

- At least **two** units must be taken from the one language for the Certificate and at least **three** units must be taken from the one language for the Diploma. Please contact the Department of Ancient History at enrolment to confirm your study pattern.
- The Certificate is a 1 to 2 years program of study (part-time).
- The Diploma is a 2 to 3 years program of study (part-time).
